**Entries accepted via FTMS or on paper. There is a non-refundable Administration Fee of
£3. Entry fees payable on the day, prior to the start of the Trial.**

Separate cheques must be sent for each Administration Fee and Entry fee.

Entry Fee cheques will be destroyed if no run offered.

All persons attending the trial must consider themselves under the control of the Chief Steward and Officials.

Substitutions will be allowed up to 7 days prior to the Trial.

Definition of a Novice Stake:

*Retrievers, Spaniels and Breeds which Hunt, Point and Retrieve: A Stake which is confined to dogs which have not gained a place
which would qualify them for first preference in the draw for Open Stakes.*
