## Definitions

Puppy: Confined to dogs of specific breed or breeds less than eighteen months of age on the date of the Test.

Novice: A dog which has not gained a 1st in a Novice Working Test. 1st 2nd or 3rd in an Open Test or any awards in Field Trials.

Open: Open to all dogs of a specified breed or breeds, although preference may be given to dogs which have gained a place or certificate of merit at a Field Trial, been placed first, second or third in an open GWT, or won a Novice GWT.

**Rules of Working Test**

This event shall be run in accordance with Welsh Assembly Government COVID-19 guidance at the time of the event. Strict adherence to hygiene measures must be observed by all.

1. All dogs must be registered by the Kennel Club and the test will be run under the rules of the Kennel Club.
2. Tests will be run in the order shown.
3. Competitors arriving after the completion of the first exercise of any Test which they have entered will be eliminated and entry forfeited. Special circumstances considered by the Committee.
4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries and cancel any Test for which insufficient entries have been received without further notice.
5. The Club will not accept responsibility for any injury, loss or damage to any person, dog or property however occasioned.
