Definitions

<u>Puppy</u>: Confined to dogs of specific breed or breeds less than eighteen months of age on the date of the Test.

<u>Novice</u>: A dog which has not gained a 1st in a Novice Working Test. 1st 2nd or 3rd in an Open Test or any awards in Field Trials.

<u>Open</u>: Open to all dogs of a specified breed or breeds, although preference may be given to dogs which have gained a place or certificate of merit at a Field Trial, been placed first, second or third in an open GWT, or won a Novice GWT.

Rules of Working Test
