Definitions

<u>Puppy</u>: Confined to dogs of specific breed or breeds less than eighteen months of age on the date of the Test.

Novice : Confined to dogs which have not gained a place or certificate of merit at a field trial, been placed first, second or third in an Open GWT or first in a Novice GWT held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations.

Open : Open to all dogs in the Retriever sub-group that are registered at the Kennel Club. i.e. All retriever breeds inc Irish Water Spaniels <u>This test is open to members and non-members equally. If, entering as a member at</u> <u>members' rates, please ensure you are a fully paid-up member prior to entering the Test. Do</u> not hesitate to contact <u>me if you are unsure of your membership subscription records.</u>

Rules of Working Test

- 1. All dogs must be registered by the Kennel Club and the test will be run under the rules of the Kennel Club.
- 2. Tests will be run in the order shown.
- 3. Competitors arriving after the completion of the first exercise of any Test which they have entered will be eliminated and entry forfeited. Special circumstances considered by the Committee.
- 4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries and cancel any Test for which insufficient entries have been received without further notice.
