Definitions

Puppy : Confined to dogs of specific breed or breeds less than eighteen months of age on the date of the Test.

Novice : Confined to dogs which have not gained a place or certificate of merit at a field trial, been placed first, second or third in an Open GWT or first in a Novice GWT held in accordance with Kennel Club Rules and Field Trial Regulations.

Open : Open to all dogs in the Retriever sub-group that are registered at the Kennel Club. i.e. All retriever breeds inc Irish Water Spaniels

Rules of Working Test

1. All dogs must be registered by the Kennel Club and the test will be run under the rules of the Kennel Club.
2. Tests will be run in the order shown.
3. Competitors arriving after the completion of the first exercise of any Test which they have entered will be eliminated and entry forfeited. Special circumstances considered by the Committee.
4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries and cancel any Test for which insufficient entries have been received without further notice.
